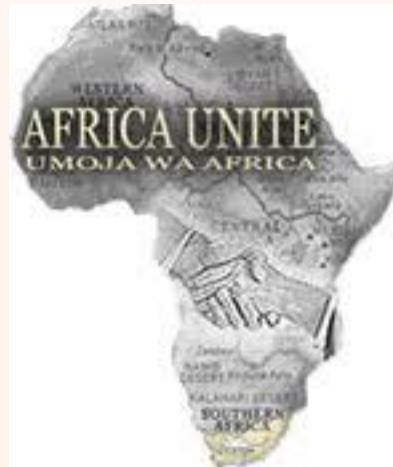


My Africa Unite Experience
