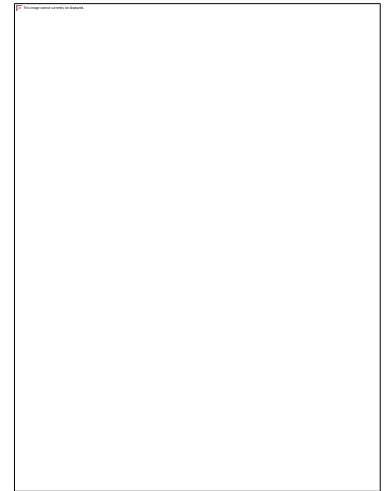
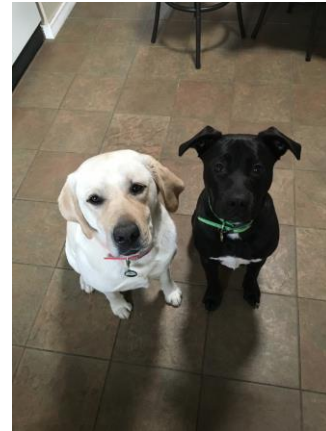

Worked on DICE III and LIBRE for UNESCO with Bongeka

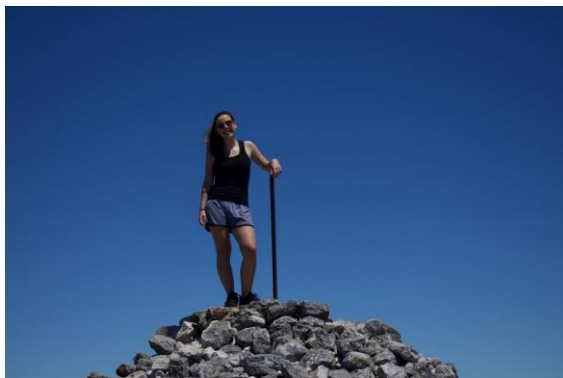
- Finding schools, teachers, and learners to participate
